THE THIRTY-SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

G E H L O N G

Infirmary and Benevolent Asylum

(Incorporated.)

THE COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT herewith present to the Subscribers and Friends of the Institution the following Report with the Financial Statement for the past year and a half.

During the eighteen months ending 30th June, 1888, 4654 cases have received relief, viz. :—

1135 Indoor Patients.
 196 Inmates of the Benevolent Asylum,
 3323 Outdoor Hospital Cases.

Of the Hospital Cases,

977 were discharged, cured or relieved.
 100 died.
 58 were under treatment on June 30th, 1888.

Of the Inmates of the Benevolent Asylum,

49 were discharged or left at their own request.
 39 died.
 108 remained on June 30th, 1888.

The daily average in the Institution has been 157. The rate of mortality, 10 per cent. for all cases, and 8.5 per cent. for the Hospital in-patients, which will compare very favorably with other institutions.

The total remaining in the House on June 30th, 1888—166.

Returns showing the ages of both male and female Patients are given elsewhere. The attendances of all Members of the General Committee of Management, as also on the House, Finance, and Sub-Committees, are likewise given.

The Financial Statement for the eighteen months shows the total receipts to have been £8518 2s. 2d., with an expenditure of £8984 11s. 7d. for maintenance, buildings, &c.; while £291 3s. has been carried to the Endowment Fund, which latter now amounts to £2426 13s.

While there is shown a debit balance of £634 17s. 2d., there is £750 due from the Government for the last quarter of the year 1887-8, which has since been received.

The following amounts are specially acknowledged :—£50 from Mr. George Hague; £30 from the Hon. and Mrs. M. H. Davies, of Melbourne; £10 10s. from Mr. Wm. Higgins; £3 from Mr. Richard Clarke—as Jubilee offerings. Fifty guineas from Mr. John Sanderson, of London; £50 *re* Estate of F. Brequet, deceased, per Mr. J. H. Downs; £100 *re* Estate of the late P. Preston, per Messrs. Wm. McMullen and D. McIntosh; £20 from the Manchester Unity I.O. Oddfellows, in July, 1887, and £20 ditto in May, 1888.

During the past eighteen months the Bye-laws of the Institution have been amended by the Subscribers (in accordance with the recommendation of the Committee) by altering the date of the Annual Meeting, which will now be held on the last Thursday in July in each year, instead of (as heretofore) the second Thursday in January, which has necessitated the present Committee remaining eighteen months in office.

Recently new quarters have been erected at considerable expense for the nurses' accommodation, and arrangements made for female nurses to take the place of wardsmen where practicable.

Water-pipes have been extended, both inside and outside the building, and hoses, &c., have been provided in the passages, both above and below, as recommended by the Inspector of Charities, in case of any outbreak of fire.

The Committee would convey to the Honorary Medical Staff their sincere thanks for the valuable services rendered by them to the Institution during the last eighteen months; as likewise to the many kind friends who from time to time, either individually or collectively, have contributed greatly to further the interest of this Charity.

The late Resident Surgeon, Dr. Newman, having resigned, after more than six years' connection with the Institution, the Committee, while sincerely regretting his loss, feel pleasure in acknowledging his past valued services, and heartily wish him every

success in his future professional career; and the Committee have to report that at a recent meeting held to select a successor to Dr. Newman, Dr. Marwood was unanimously elected to the position of Resident Medical Officer.

The Committee most sincerely regret the loss sustained in the removal by death of the late Mr. George Cakebread, whose valued services on the General, and especially on the Sub-Committees, were greatly appreciated.

The House and Finance Committees during the past eighteen months have had very great and responsible duties devolving upon them, and the sincere and hearty thanks of the General Committee of Management is accorded to them.

The thanks of the Committee are also tendered to all those who have forwarded contributions, such as books, illustrated and other papers, flowers, fruit, etc., etc., for the use of the Inmates; and, in conclusion, they earnestly hope to receive a continuance of such gifts, which are always greatly appreciated by the Inmates.
