At this time COLDWELL farmed 90 acres at Paraparap. He sold the farm during 1878, before moving to Belmont where he died on 31 Oct 1896.
Sabina received £400 as first charge on her husband's estate. She remained a widow until her death, leaving just over £200 before expenses. She is buried in Geelong Eastern Cemetery (grave MET/1/09), where her first husband occupies an unknown grave.
Both the GLIDDON and COLDWELL families had strong allegiances to the Methodist church, serving as organisers and representatives, and being involved in musical activities.
