No street address given but probably Gertrude St, Geelong West as daughters Emma and Robina signed from there. Five children born Ashby 1856 to 1869. Buried with daughter Emma Higgins.

Meakin Street in East Geelong was named after Sarah's brother: Meakin Street commemorates Ald. Henry Meakin, Mayor of Geelong in Queen Victoria's Jubilee year - 1887. He arrived in Geelong from Derbyshire in 1851 and erected a steam-driven sawmill on the foreshore at Griffins Gully Western Beach. He was better known as a publican, however, and for many years ran the Derby Arms Hotel. Earlier he had used the same name when conducting the hotel which later became the now defunct Albion Hotel - also in Little Malop Street. He was closely associated with public affairs and was a driving force in the removal of the bar at Point Henry. As a mark of recognition for his services in the development of the Hopetoun Channel, the newly constituted Harbor Trust Commissioners in 1906 named a steam hopper barge in his honour.
